## **Biographies**

#### Samuel Beckett Writer

Samuel Beckett was an Irish playwright, novelist, theatre director, poet and literary translator and is one of the most influential writers of the 20th century. He spent most of his adult life in France including during World War II where he was a member of the French resistance. He won many awards including the Nobel Prize in Literature in 1969. Two awards have been set up in his name: the Samuel Beckett Award (1983) and the Oxford Samuel Beckett Theatre Trust Award (2003). His plays include *Endgame*, *Krapp's Last Tape*, *All That Fall*, *Happy Days*, *Act Without Words I*, *Come and Go*, *Eh Joe*, *Play*, *Breath*, *Not I*, *Footfalls*, *Rockaby*, *Catastrophe* and *Quad*.

#### Joan Oliver Director

Joan graduated from RADA's three year acting programme in 1993, after which she appeared in a number of Theatre, TV, Film, and radio productions. Alongside her acting, Joan began establishing herself as a teacher and freelance director.

She returned to RADA in 2009, when she became RADA's Education and Outreach Manager, and held this role until 2014, when she took up her position as RADA's Foundation in Acting Course Director. Joan continued in this role until 2021, when she moved into her most recent position as RADA's first Director of Equity.

Joan's directing at RADA includes *random* (debbie tucker green), *Rotterdam* (Jon Brittain), *The Seagull* (Anton Chekhov), which she also adapted, and most recently *NSFW* (Lucy Kirkwood).




